IMPORTANT REMINDERS / Please read upon receiving this information.

- 1. DO NOT EAT FOOD OR DRINK BEVERAGES AFTER MIDNIGHT (unless bowel prep instructs otherwise).
- You will be given sedation for your procedure and will be unable to drive yourself home. Per Riverview
 Health policy, you are required to have a driver come with you and stay the entire time you are at the
 hospital. The endoscopy staff must speak to your driver to confirm their availability. Typically, you will
 spend 2 to 3 hours at the facility.
- 3. Call our office at least one (1) week prior to your procedure if you: 1) take <u>blood thinners</u> or 2) have an <u>automatic internal cardiac defibrillator (AICD)</u>. If this information was discussed when scheduling your appointment, it is not necessary to call.
- 4. Unless instructed otherwise, you may and are encouraged to take necessary medications with water on the day of your exam. Bring your complete list of medications to your appointment.
- 5. If you take diabetic medications: <u>Insulin</u> take ½ dosage the evening prior to the procedure and skip your morning dose on the day of your procedure. <u>Blood sugar control pills</u> (oral hypoglycemics) skip your doses the evening prior to and the morning of procedure. <u>Glucagon-Like Peptide-1 (GLP-1) agonist</u> see #6 below. *If you have questions, please contact the physician that prescribes your diabetic medications.*
- 6. If you take a <u>GLP-1 agonist</u> for diabetes or weight loss: Do NOT take Byetta, Saxenda, Victoza, Adlyxin or Rybelsus on the day of your procedure. Do NOT take Trulicity, Bydureon BCise, Ozempic, Wegovy or Mounjaro within 7 days of your procedure.

7. Bring your PHOTO ID and HEALTH INSURANCE CARD.

- 8. Please leave your valuables (jewelry, watches, etc.) at home.
- 9. Please check with your insurance if you have concerns regarding benefits. Our office will contact your insurance company for pre-authorization requirements; however, we do not check your schedule of benefits. Per your insurance company's disclaimer, authorization for your procedure does not guarantee payment.
- 10. Our guidelines do not require antibiotics to be given prior to endoscopy for any conditions apart from feeding tube placement. *If you have concerns about this, please bring it to the attention of the nurse and physician prior to sedation.*
